| ___ | 8. Mikayel Nalbandian | c. | Painter (20 century), captured the rich earthen colors of the Armenian landscape under the powerful Armenian sun. |
| ___ | 9. St. Thaddeus or Tateos | d. | One of Jesus' 12 disciples, he was invested with the gift of language by the Holy Spirit on Pentecost and traveled to Armenia |
| ___ | 10. St. Vartan Mamikonian | e. | Armenian classical composer. His best known works are Spartak (Spartacus) and Gayane, the latter featuring the now ubiquitous Sabre Dance. |

| ___ | 3. | St. Santookht | c. | Patron saint of Armenia, The first Catholicos of the Armenian Church, he is the true founder of Armenian Christianity. |
